



Dear Kindergarten Families,

In Unit 11, students will work with the following Kindergarten Common Core standards in the Measurement and Data (MD) domain.

K.MD.1	Describe measurable attributes of objects, such as length or weight. Describe several measurable attributes of a single object.
K.MD.2	Directly compare two objects with a measurable attribute in common, to see which object has “more of”/ “less of” the attribute, and describe the difference. For example, directly compare the heights of two children and describe one child as taller/shorter.

Unit 11 Concepts:

- Describe the measurable attributes
- Compare two objects with a common and measurable attribute

Unit 11 Vocabulary:

Ask questions like these to help your child become a productive mathematical thinker:

- Is my arm longer, or is yours?
- Find a pencil shorter than this one.
- Who is taller, you or your sister?
- Who is shorter, me or you?
- Which do you think is heavier, a watermelon or an apple?
- Can you think of something that is lighter than this juice box?
- Which has greater volume (holds more), my coffee cup or the coffee pot?
- Which holds less milk (has less volume), the gallon in our refrigerator or the carton you get with a school lunch?
- Which has a greater capacity, the box of cereal or the box of macaroni and cheese?
