In Unit 6, students will build on the on the following Kindergarten Common Core standards in the Operations and Algebraic Thinking (OA) domain.

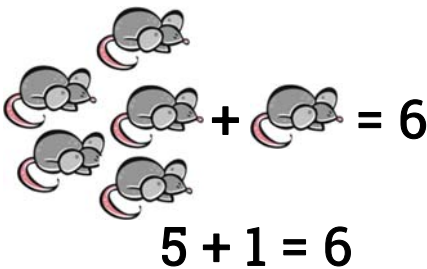
K.OA.1	Represent addition and subtraction with objects, fingers, mental images, drawing, sounds, acting out situation, verbal explanations, expressions, or equations.
K.OA.2	Solve addition and subtraction word problems, and add and subtract within 10, e.g., by using objects or drawing to represent the problem.

Unit 6 Concepts:

Ask questions like these to help your child become a productive mathematical thinker:

- You already had two pieces of broccoli on your plate. I gave you three more. How many pieces do you have now?
- If four people join us for dinner tonight, how many people will have dinner?
- Here are three pennies. If I add six more, how many will there be?
- Show me a total of ten blocks. Show me two ways you can join them to make ten (for example, $7 + 3$ or $5 + 5$).
- What is 0 plus 5?
- If you and your brother combine your candies, how many would you have?
- You and I both have two eyes. How many eyes do we have all together?
- Represent $5 + 4$ with a drawing.
